Paid Park Host

Yolo County is offering an opportunity for people that enjoy the outdoors and meeting new people to come stay at our Cache Creek Regional Campground.

What are the duties of a park host?

- Greet campers and day users, answer their questions and orient them to the park and region.
- Understand and be able to explain park rules and regulations.
- Collect fees, book keeping, and cash handling.
- Assist with general campground maintenance: pick up litter, clean campsites after guests check out, replenish rest room supplies and assist in keeping the bathrooms clean, empty trash cans if needed.
- Contact park staff and/or other law enforcement personnel about park emergencies.
- Other projects or assignments based on park needs and hosts' skills and interests.

What are the benefits of being a park host?

In exchange for 20 hours of work a week, park hosts will receive:

- \$600 per month
- RV hook-up which includes propane, electric, water, sewage and cement pad.
- Daily use of park facilities, such as water access, fishing, boat docks, hiking and wildlife observing.
- Opportunity's to meet many people from around California and the world.
