The Arthur F. Turner Community Library provides group study rooms for the community members to meet and work on group projects. Rooms are available free of charge during open library hours and can be reserved on a first come, first served basis at the library Information Desk. There are two group study rooms, each equipped with desks, chairs, and write and wipe boards.

To sign-up for the group study room, please come to the library information desk located across from the library public computer room.

Group Study Room Policies

- Sign-ups will be on a first come, first serve basis. No advance reservations are accepted.
- Study rooms may be used for 1 hour sessions.
- Groups may use the room more than once per day unless others are waiting.
- There is a minimum group size of 2 persons and a maximum of 4 persons per session.
- The library does not provide study materials or equipment for group study room use.
- No food or drinks (except drinks in closed containers) will be permitted in the rooms.
- Group study room users agree to abide by this policy, the library's Patron Conduct Policy, and all instructions from library staff.
- Students must vacate the room/s 15 minutes prior to library closing.
- The Library will not be responsible for loss or damage of personal items left in group study rooms.
