RF. Interim Review of Off Channel Minning Plan (OCMP)

Dear Ms Fiack:

This is our response to your letter of May -') 1, 2005 in relating to the above reference subject.

Since 1996 when the Board of Supervisors adopted the Cache Creek Area Plan, there have been a few changes in regulations and policies that affected the ffinctions of Enviro=ental Health: The California Uniform Retail Food Codes were amended to strengthen certain areas of food safety; the Health and Safety Code were amended to lower the allowable contamination level on certain contaminants for drinking water and the Central Valley Regional Quality Control Board had amended the Basin Plan to clarify and strengthen the guidelines on liquid wastes disposal. However, it appears that none of these changes would have a significant impact on off-channel mining in Yolo County. Our office would be happy to participate in the review process of the OCNIP and to offer our input on comments from the other agencies that may be related to environmenw health.
