Free Holiday Recycling at the County Landfill

(Woodland, CA) – Free treecycling of holiday trees and recycling other holiday materials is being offered at the Yolo County Central Landfill December 26 through January 16 and at the Esparto Convenience Center December 26 through January 17.

“Please join us in making the commitment to be more sustainable in the new year,” said Yolo County Board of Supervisors Chair Mike McGowan. “Holiday trees are biodegradable and will eventually decompose to provide essential organic matter. By recycling your holiday tree, gift boxes and bottles and cans from holiday celebrations, you help reduce waste in our landfill and are doing your part to help the environment.”

Trees to be recycled should have all ornaments, flocking, tinsel, garland and/or lights removed. Holiday trees, cardboard, bottles and cans can be recycled for free at the following locations:
