- TCP/IP is the only protocol supported

Configuring Windows 7

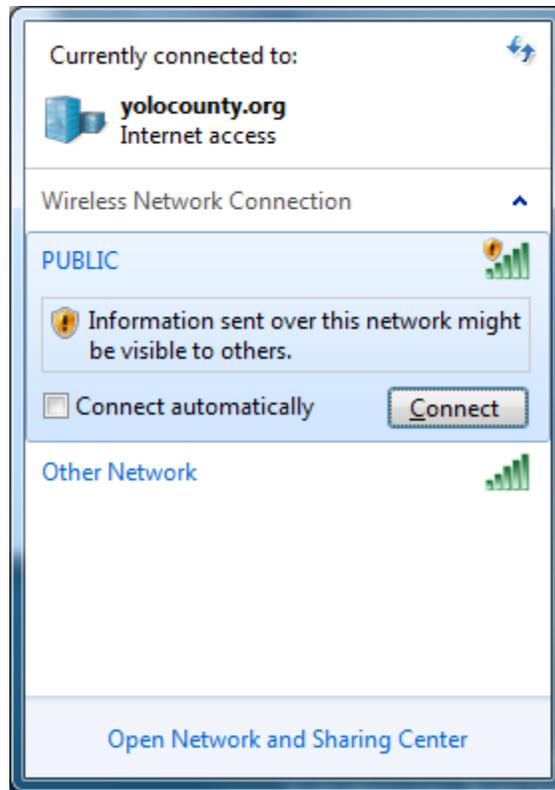
1) Click the Network Connection icon on the task bar. Windows 7 will scan the network and provide you

with a list of all available wireless networks.

- 1) click  and go to control panel.
- 2) click "Network and Internet"
- 3) click "Connect to a Network:"
