“As additional supplies of Novel H1N1 vaccine are now available, I encourage all Yolo County residents to take advantage of one of these opportunities,” said Dr. Joseph Iser, Yolo County Health Department Director-Health Officer. “This is also an opportunity for parents of children, age 6 months to ten years who have received the first Novel H1N1 shot, to bring their children in for a booster shot.”
