Emeka A. Akamike to Speak at West Sacramento Library January 16

(Woodland, CA) – As part of the Yolo County Library Local Author Series, author, scientist and healthcare advocate Emeka A. Akamike will be speak at the Arthur F. Turner Community Library branch at 1212 Merkley Avenue in West Sacramento on January 16, 5:00 to 6:30 p.m. Admission is free.

Mr. Akamike is the author of two medial novels based on a lifetime of work as a research scientist in the areas of industrial chemistry and medicinal chemistry.
