NOTICE OF SPECIAL PUBLIC MEETINGS

The Yolo County Cache Creek Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) will be conducting two special public meetings on Monday March 15 and Wednesday March 17, 2010 to locate bench marks and transects along Lower Cache Creek. The meetings will begin each day at 8:30 am at: the Yolo County Parks and Resources Department (PRD), 120 W. Main Street, Suite C, Woodland CA 95695. After meeting at the PRD office, we will depart the office for various locations along Lower Cache Creek.

PLEASE NOTE: In order to access many of the locations the TAC must do so on foot. Walking over uneven terrain and through dense brush within the channel may be required. Clothing appropriate for weather conditions and personal products such as sun block, sunglasses, food, water, toiletries, mosquito repellent, rain gear and any other items appropriate for enduring the natural elements and terrain will be necessary. Rattlesnakes, bees, mountain lions, and other potentially hostile wildlife may be encountered. Public restrooms will not be available. The use of private vehicles on public and/or unpaved private roads will be necessary.
