#### Item № 7a Discussed notification from County to potentially move LAFCO office

Staff notified the Commission that Assistant County Administrator Pat Leary mentioned the possibility of relocating the LAFCO office to allow the Public Guardian/Administrator to move into the space LAFCO staff currently occupies.

The County is also considering alternative locations for both the Public Guardian and LAFCO.

The Commission discussed LAFCO office expectations and considered issues such as public visibility and autonomy.

#### <u>Item № 7b</u> <u>Consider as appropriate</u>

A verbal report was given on potential LAFCO proposals and pending and active municipal service review and sphere of influence (MSR/SOI) studies.

Active studies include the City of Woodland/Springlake Fire Protection District, Wild Wings County Service Area and the Cemetery Districts MSR/SOI's.

Potential proposals include the Woodland Gateway-Phase II South Annexation to the City of Woodland and the UCD West Village Annexation to the City of Davis.
