April Kicks Off Child Abuse Prevention Month

(Woodland, CA) – April 7, 2010 – Yolo County District Attorney Jeff Reisig encourages the public to participate in the county's child abuse prevention efforts during the month of April. "We are committed to holding those who harm children accountable for their actions, but the key to ending child abuse is in prevention through education and community awareness," says Reisig. Reisig reports that while the DA's Office vigorously prosecutes child abusers, every prosecutor involved in child abuse cases wishes their job was not necessary. "Child abuse is often a crime that goes unnoticed or unreported" reports Cameron Handley, Director of Yolo County's Multi-Disciplinary Interview Center. "Many people believe that it is not their business to become involved, but protecting our community's children so they can grow into healthy adults is everyone's business," says Handley.

Yolo County receives approximately 2,000 reports of alleged child abuse each year. While social workers, police officers, and prosecutors work hard to investigate, prosecute, and protect children, the best solution to child abuse is prevention through education, early intervention, and support services for families at risk. "Children are our most innocent and valuable citizens," says Reisig. "We are committed to prosecuting those who hurt them, but it takes the whole community to protect and nurture them." The District Attorney's Office will be participating in a panel discussion of the handling of child sexual abuse cases at the 16th Annual Northern CA Child Sexual Abuse Awareness Conference taking place at the Davis Senior Center this Saturday.
