# **Mental Health Services Act**

Community Services and Supports (CSS) and Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI) FY 2009/10 Prudent Reserve Funding Request

### **Background Information:**

On August 6, 2009, the California Department of Mental Health (DMH) issued DMH Information Notice No. 09-16, Mental Health Services Act Local Prudent Reserve (Prudent Reserve) Fiscal Policy Changes. This information notice, which includes a detailed review of the mechanisms and restrictions associated with funding the county's Prudent Reserve, may be found on the Internet at http://www.dmh.ca.gov/DMHDocs/2009 Notices.asp.

In pertinent part, Information Notice No. 09-16 states:

Because the [Mental Health Services] Act does not specify the 20% transfer from CSS funding mechanism until FY 2008-2009, DMH has determined that Counties may use both CSS and PEI funds made available prior to FY 2008/09 to fund their Prudent Reserve. This would include CSS and PEI funds that were approved through a Plan update and distributed to Counties, but which have not been expended (unexpended funds) and/or funds that were not requested or approved (unapproved funds) remaining in Planning Estimates for years prior to FY 2008/09.

In other words, Yolo County is able to request that unspent or unapproved CSS or <u>PEI</u> funding from Fiscal Year 2007-08 be dedicated to its Local Prudent Reserve.

In Fiscal Year 2007-08, Yolo County was in the community planning stage and did not yet have an approved PEI component of its MHSA Plan. As a result, much of Yolo County's Prevention and Early Intervention Planning Estimate for FY 2007-08 (\$570,700) remained unspent. Yolo County proposes dedicating \$480,017 of unspent Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI) funding from Fiscal Year 2007-08 to its Local Prudent Reserve.

DMH has given California counties until June 30, 2011 to fund their Local Prudent Reserves under MHSA at an amount equivalent to 50 percent (50%) of the most recent approved funding level for the Community Services and Supports (CSS) and Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI) levels. Yolo County's Local Prudent Reserve should be approximately \$2.3 Million dollars; however, due to current economic conditions, only a small percentage of funds have been set aside to date.

In order to contribute funding to its Local Prudent Reserve, Yolo County Department of Alcohol, Drug and Mental Health will submit the attached *Mental Health Services Act (MHSA)*Community Services and Supports (CSS) and Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI) FY 2009/10 Prudent Reserve Funding Request to DMH following the 30-day public review and comment period, as set forth below.

### Documentation of the local review process:

Commencing May 14, 2010 and ending at 5:00 p.m. on June 14, 2010, the *Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Community Services and Supports (CSS) and Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI) FY 2009/10 Prudent Reserve Funding Request for Yolo County was posted for 30-day public review and comment on the county's website: <a href="http://www.yolocounty.org/Index.aspx?page=993">http://www.yolocounty.org/Index.aspx?page=993</a>.* 

Paper copies of the document were sent to all public libraries in Yolo County, with the request that the document be made available for public viewing at the resource desk during regular hours of operation.

Paper copies of the document were delivered to mental health service centers in Woodland, Davis and West Sacramento, and to the Department of Social Services "One-Stop" center in Woodland.

The stakeholder community was notified of the public posting and public review process by e-mail to all interested parties and by the publishing of announcements in the Woodland Daily Democrat and the Davis Enterprise, local newspapers with daily circulation.
