Free Financial Workshop for Teens at the West Sacramento Library

(Woodland, CA) – The Yolo County Library will be offering a financial workshop for teens at the Arthur F. Turner Community Library, located at 1212 Merkley Avenue in West Sacramento, on July 16, 4:00 to 5:30 p.m. The workshop, entitled "Don't Break the Bank," will address topics such as budgets, setting financial goals, checking and saving accounts, credit, investing and careers. "Don't Break the Bank" will be conducted by Nicole Bridge, Marketing Coordinator for the Yolo Federal Credit Union (YFCU). Ms. Bridge spearheads YFCU's Financial Literacy program and coordinates their newly developed and highly successful on-site school savings program called "CU at School." Ms. Bridget has been working for YFCU since August 2008, and in her spare time coaches the Vacaville High School dance team and teaches at a dance studio, also in Vacaville.

"It is never too early to learn how to manage one's finances," said Yolo County Supervisor Mike McGowan. "This Yolo County Library workshop is specifically geared toward teens, but parents are welcome too."
