JURY CONVICTS THREE STRIKER IN DAVIS RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY

(Woodland, CA) – District Attorney Jeff Reisig announced that on June 25, 2010, a Yolo County Superior Court jury convicted Lee Ray Williams of Solano County of first degree burglary for the December 2009 burglary of the Davis home of his daughter and ex girlfriend, the child's mother. Mr. Williams, who had been in and out of their lives over the years, had been invited to attend his daughter's school function that December evening shortly before Christmas, but cancelled at the last moment and instead took advantage of the fact that no one was home to burglarize their home. Some of the stolen property was later recovered from Mr. Williams' apartment.

Williams has an extensive criminal history of felony convictions, including a 1992 robbery of Yolo Federal Credit Union and a robbery of a McDonalds in Fairfield. On Monday June 28th, the jury also found true that the defendant had suffered "strike" convictions which under California law cause him to face a potential sentence of life in prison. He is scheduled to be sentenced by the Honorable Paul Richardson on July 26, 2010 in Dept. 6 of the Yolo County Superior Court.
