Foreclosure Workshop at West Sacramento Library July 21

(Woodland, CA) – As part of the Yolo County Library "Living and Learning in Yolo Series," attorney and author Alysa Meyer with Legal Services of Northern California will present a free Foreclosure Workshop on July 21, 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m., at the Arthur F. Turner Community Library located at 1212 Merkley Avenue in West Sacramento. This workshop will provide information on avoiding or navigating the foreclosure process. Advance registration is required.

Alysa Meyer is the managing attorney of the Yolo County office of Legal Services of Northern California (LSNC). She provides representation and advocacy on behalf of low-income individuals in matters such as housing, homelessness prevention, public benefits, education, employment and health rights. Ms. Meyer also advises nonprofit organizations, including those dedicated to serving the poor and chronically homeless.

Ms. Meyer has worked for LSNC for eight years. She obtained her undergraduate degree from UC Davis and her juris doctorate from Santa Clara University School of Law. She was admitted to practice law in California in 1994. Prior to working for LSNC, Ms. Meyer worked for Contra Costa Legal Services Foundation in the housing unit. Later, she worked for a mid-sized insurance defense firm in Sacramento.
