

2010 Creek Walk Inspection Sites

REACH - CAPAY

Capay Dam (RM 28.4): Access may not be possible unless we walk 1.5 miles from Pacific Palisades. Construction on apron begins Sept 15, 2010.

Pacific Palisades - PG&E (RM 26.9) Identify and track nick point migration over time. Monitor and estimate its travel speed.

Teichert Bank Protection Project (RM 23-22.8)

Scheuring Property (RM 21.7-21.5) A long-rang examination of the dynamics at the Scheuring Property (Old Madison Bridge Site) is needed considering the tendencies and the likely future migration.

SYAR Property (RM 21.7-21.5) OHV, trespassing, and vandalism issues

Nature Preserve (RM 16.5-15.9) habitat restoration plan for the Nature Preserve that incorporate grading and wetland construction to control turbidity problem emanating from Salisbury/Gordon Slough.

Correll-Rodgers (RM 13.9-13.4) new projects/phases are on hold (only maintenance will ensue). Natural barriers need to be installed to prevent trespassing by OHV's.

REACH – RIO JESUS MARIA

Structure Falling in Creek (RM 12.2) Access may be a problem. Some clean up of material in the creek done by CCC. Material is still in creek and one structure is in danger of falling into creek.
