Revised: County Road 28H Closure: September 13-30 Closure between County Roads 102 and 105

(Woodland, CA) – The reconstruction of County Road 28H, which was previously reported to begin on September 7, has been delayed one week. Construction from County Road 104 to approximately 1,500 feet east of the Yolo County Central Landfill entrance is now scheduled to begin September 13 and to be completed by September 30. During construction, County Road 28H, between County Roads 102 and 105, will be closed to all traffic.

During construction, the Yolo County Central Landfill will remain open. A signed detour route will be provided. Landfill-related traffic should follow the detour signs to the construction entrance. Access to properties located along the closed road segments will be provided by the contractor.

Commuters who use County Road 28H between County Roads 102 and 105 are advised to plan an alternate route, as the road will be closed to through traffic.

In addition to the reconstruction of County Road 28H, this project also includes widening the landfill entrance to four lanes for better traffic flow to the new scalehouse and scale, as well as additional road reconstruction and other improvements to the landfill's interior access roads. The existing road materials will be recycled in place by "Full Depth Recycling," an environmentally sustainable practice, recycling 100% of the road in place and producing a high quality road structural section at the lowest possible cost. This eliminates the removal and disposal of the existing road surface and the import of new replacement material.

The road construction project will cost \$1,065,420 and will be completed by Teichert Construction. PBM Construction is the contractor for the scalehouse project.
