WORKSHOPS MARK BEGINNING OF METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION PLAN UPDATE Public invited to weigh in on major transportation issues

SACRAMENTO—In 2008, the Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG) adopted the Metropolitan Transportation Plan for 2035 (MTP), a long-range plan for transportation in the region built on the smart land use Blueprint project. Since the last MTP, California adopted Senate Bill 375, which requires a Sustainable Communities Strategy, similar to the Blueprint, to be added to transportation plans across the state. The downturn in the economy has also resulted in less money for transportation, and SACOG will be factoring these changes into the update.

SACOG is hosting nine community workshops in October to determine local priorities. Participants will act as citizen planners, giving feedback on different options for future transportation growth—from roads, to transit, to bicycle lanes and sidewalks. This input comes at the beginning of a process lasting through December 2011.
