Update by Jim Rosaschi, Yolo County Library – Part 2
September 12, 2010

Construction is on schedule, and looking great. Here are some pictures that show the progress with emphasis on the Children's areas, Friends of Davis Public Library, and the staff areas.



Two group study rooms that can each seat 5 people are shown here. Four additional two-person study rooms are available, and all can be reserved.



The Children's Room Service Desk is located centrally, with the new expansion area behind the plastic sheeting to the left.



The Children's Room service desk can be seen beyond the plastic sheeting. Fiction and Non-Fiction books for older children will go in this room. The activities room is just behind us in this view. The Adult Fiction collection is beyond the window. Both this room and the activities room are new and are part of the expansion of the library



This is the view from the Children's Room entry through the library and into the adult non-fiction room. The desk at the center of the picture is the main service desk, and the main entrance is to the right of the white bucket on the floor.



This is the work area set aside for the Friends of Davis Public Library. The items on the floor are for temporary construction storage.



This is a view of the hallway in the staff area and some existing cabinets that are being saved and re-used to save money and because they are still in good shape,



The automated materials handling system will let people check in their own items and get a receipt. The openings in the far wall are both for the traditional “book drop”, a mailbox-like hinged drop slot as well as for the conveyers where items can be fed into the library’s new system. The little window to the left will allow people a peek at the new equipment.
