On September 30, 2010 at 7:00 am the Yolo County Sheriff's Department Animal Services Section responded to Danville Apartments, 1221 Kennedy Place, Davis for a dog found alive in a Waste Management dumpster by the complex maintenance person. Upon arrival Animal Services found an elderly gray Terrier mix female lying in the trash. Weak in the rear legs the dog was unable to stand. The Terrier had no identification.

The officer removed the little Terrier and transported her to UC Davis Veterinary Teaching Hospital for emergency care. Veterinarian stated it appeared the weakness in the hind limbs was from age and not trauma.
