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Immunization Clinic Hours Changed to Wednesdays, 2:00 to 5:00 p.m.

(Woodland, CA) – Beginning February 2, the Yolo County Health Department's immunization clinic, held at the Health Department located at 137 N. Cottonwood Street in Suite 1400 in Woodland, will now be held on Wednesdays from 2:00 to 5:00 p.m.

The immunization clinic provides all childhood vaccines for infants through teens, including the meningitis vaccine and the vaccine to prevent human papilloma virus, the main cause of cervical cancer. The clinic also provides the Tdap vaccine, which vaccinates for pertussis (whooping cough), diphtheria and tetanus along with seasonal flu vaccine. The first vaccine costs \$10 with additional vaccines costing \$3 each, per visit. Clients unable to pay for vaccines will not be turned away.

Please note, the immunization clinic has moved to Suite 1400 in the Herbert Bauer Health and Alcohol, Drug & Mental Health Building, located at 137 N. Cottonwood in Woodland. The Vital Records office, previously found at this location, is now housed in the Clerk-Recorder's office, located in the Erwin W. Meier Administration Building located at 625 Court Street, Room B01 in Woodland.
