Free Tire Recycling for Woodland Residents on April 16

(Woodland, CA) – Yolo County, in cooperation with the City of Woodland’s bulky waste collection program, is hosting a free tire recycling event for Woodland residents on April 16, 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. at the Yolo County Fairgrounds (enter on Gibson Road). During this one day event, sponsored by California Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), there will be no charge for the disposal of used tires.

During this event, there will be a limit of nine tires per vehicle. Farmers and ranchers may contact the Yolo County Farm Bureau at (530) 662-6316 to obtain a hauling permit allowing for transport of up to 20 tires per vehicle.

- All passenger car, truck, and farm tractor tires with or without rims and that are air filled with no solid areas will be accepted.
- Heavy equipment tires and tires with a diameter greater than 60 inches will not be accepted.
- Tire bins full of tires will not be accepted. If you have tire bins full of tires you may contact Shamrock Recycling, Inc. at (916) 343-6282 for proper management of your tires.

“California generates 44 million scrap tires a year,” said Yolo County Board of Supervisors Chair Matt Rexroad. “Yolo County provides these free waste tire collection events so the tires can be recycled to pave roads or for use in landslide repair and embankments.”
