NOTE:

The District provides very limited services. There is no longer any agricultural activity, the pumps are inoperable, the levee breach is not slated for repairs, and the District prefers to leave the island in its current state. The District wants to maintain the structure to allow the District to serve as the lead agency for habitat mitigation, should it be required.

Liberty Island has had major levee breaches and has been in a flooded state for over a decade. The island is almost entirely owned by The Trust for Public Land; there are two other private landowners within RD 2093. The Trust for Public Land purchased its property in 1998 with CALFED funding. The land was intended to be a part of the proposed US Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) North Delta National Wildlife Refuge, but the refuge was not established and the property has been maintained through private ownership by The Trust for Public Land ever since.
