Reclamation District 2076 has never been active as a reclamation district.

The district has no board of trustees, no adopted bylaws, has never collected any revenue and provides no services.

It was recommended by the LAFCO staff in 1983 that RD 2076 be found to have a zero sphere of influence and be dissolved, if, in one year the landowners do not implement activation of the district. The LAFCO commission supported the recommendation; however no action to dissolve the district was ever taken. It was noted by LAFCO staff that while conducting their study several landowners within the district expressed an interest in the potential beneficial services the district could provide. Although information was distributed there was never any action taken by the landowners to activate the district.

Information on file suggests that the state condemned the Bypass properties and acquired them through eminent domain; therefore, voiding the purpose of the district before trustees could be elected/appointed.
