NOTE:

In 1983 Yolo County LAFCO received a proposal to form RD 2120 (Little Holland). The proposal was denied by the LAFCO Commission. However, the state Reclamation Board (which holds a flowage easement over the entire proposed area) approved the proposed formation of the district. With the states approval the Reclamation District was formed.

In 1999 the area of the district was sold to the US Army Corps of Engineers for the purposes of habitat migration. The US Army Crops of Engineers currently maintains the function of the district. It no longer exists as a reclamation district although it was never formally dissolved.
