Tentative Schedule for Yolo County Redistricting Hearings

(Woodland, CA) – Recently, the Yolo County Board of Supervisors set the following tentative schedule for considering revised district boundaries for Yolo County:

September 13, 2011: Consider redistricting recommendations and conduct first reading of draft ordinances based on each of the Redistricting Advisory Committee's recommended maps. (Note: Board may tentatively give direction to staff concerning a final ordinance which will define the revised district boundaries.)

September 27, 2011: Possible final approval of revised map, second reading of associated ordinance and final adoption of revised district boundaries; or first reading of alternative ordinance if requested by the Board of Supervisors during their 9/13/11 meeting.

October 11, 2011: If needed, second reading of alternative ordinance and final adoption or revised district boundaries.

On February 1, 2011, the Yolo County Board of Supervisors established an advisory committee to assist them in the process of updating the supervisorial districts, as required by law. Under State law, the Redistricting Advisory Committee was required to make its recommendations to the Board of Supervisors no later than August 1, 2011. The Redistricting Advisory Committee has submitted three maps for consideration which can be found on www.yolocounty.org.

State law also requires that the Board of Supervisors adopt revised district boundaries by November 1, 2011. The adopted district boundaries will take effect for the June, 2012 primary elections for Supervisorial Districts 1, 4 and 5.
