

CITY OF WINTERS NONDISPOSAL FACILITY ELEMENT

Existing State-Permitted Facilities

Since the adoption of the Winters SRRE, there have been many changes in the City of Winters integrated solid waste operations. Refuse collection has changed from public collection to private collection. In 1994 Waste Management was selected to be the City's contractor. Waste Management collects refuse, recyclables, and yard material curbside on a weekly basis. This NDFE acknowledges that there are no state-permitted nondisposal facilities within the City's jurisdiction.

Solid Waste

Currently 100% of the City's solid waste is being taken to the Yolo County Central Landfill; this is a state-permitted disposal facility (Solid Waste Facility permit number 57-AA-001).

Yard Material

Currently green waste materials are going to Yolo County Central Landfill for use as alternative daily cover (ADC). This material is being processed by Valley By-Products, Inc.'s wood processing facility.

Valley By-Products, Inc. is currently permitted as a wood processing facility under the Yolo County Central Landfill state solid waste permit. This current permit allows for preparation of yard materials to be used as alternative daily cover at the Yolo County Central Landfill. Valley By-Products is now in the process of applying for a permit to include composting operations at this facility.

Recyclable Materials

Recyclable materials including paper, glass, metals, corrugated cardboard, and plastic which are being collected through the City's recycling programs are being processed by Woodland Disposal's facility located in Woodland at 1324 Paddock Place.

Inert Materials and Scrap Metals

The Yolo County Central Landfill permit allows for a scrap metal recovery area, concrete and asphalt reuse for roadbase, and a tire disposal collection area. These services are used by all the jurisdiction^s of Davis, West Sacramento, Winters, Woodland, and unincorporated Yolo County.

Proposed Permitted Facilities

In terms of new or expanded solid waste facilities, page 9-6 of the Winters SRRE states that "No new or expanded facilities are proposed within the City of Winters." However, there were proposed facilities located outside the Winters city limits which were discussed in the SRRE.
