A. School Update

The Secretary ask's Barbera Herm's how are things with the school?

Barbera Herm's things are doing well right now we have doubled our enrollment to 211 student's right now. The Secretary asked if they have dealt with the federal grant paperwork to allow more children from knight's landing itself to be enrolled in there school, because I have been hearing that children from this area have not been able to get into the school.

Barbera Herms: we have open enrollment December 3 we cant hold spots for kids its almost first come first serve. The lottery system is December 3 from 10:00 to 11:00 am. We are following federal guidelines for enrollment.

Wayne: are you still going to be one through sixth grade?

Barbera Herms: I cant tell you anything on that one right now we are researching that we need to make sure the move is in a quality way for seventh and eighth grade because a lot of the classes that they are taking right now can be looked at as for college admissions and we need to make sure that we do it the right way, and right now we are asking other staff and looking at the middle schools to see what and how they do things.

Secretary Ask;s where are your students coming from?

Barbera Herms; We have students from knights landing, woodland, Zamora, Davis, west sacramento.

Secretary there was an article in the paper back in September, who were you calling socioeconomically disadvantaged?

Barbera; I did not right that those were not my words that was the reporter that did that.

Secretary the other question is how prepared is the school for an emergency situation if it floods. Or 113 is closed or if you have to stop for a few days or if you have to evacuate?

Barbera; I was just going over the schools site safety report to turn into the district, we have been going over everything. From a lockdown to evacuation to all the scenarios that might possibly occur here.

Wayne; if we do have an emergency and need to use the school to hook up a generator is that possible only for an emergency though?

Barbera; ill go out on a limb and say yes.

Paul Wardlow the american red cross came out to the catholic church and asked if we do need any help

Viki; what about a seperate park so that the kids that dont go to school have a place to play because they dont now?

secretary we did have a park and the state took it out because it was to old.

Juana Gutierres we would have to have a fundraiser to get the seperate playground equipment.

B. Scout Cabin; how prepared is this place and yes i did look at things this place definitely has enough dishes, it has new doors thank you to the zumba class for painting the place. needs new ceiling.

Wayne if we do need a generator it is portable and we can use it it belongs to the service district.

Juana we can also look at the school and the clinic for any extra help and resources for not only emergency but also communications.
