### **ANNOUNCEMENTS**

- City of Davis has a program for unused items - Apartment Move-Out Waste Reduction Program (<http://cityofdavis.org/pw/recycle/moveout.cfm>).
- SSI project at Communicare is going strong with a 78% approval rate and an improving turnaround time.

### **BUDGET UPDATES**

- State Budget
  - Consistent with County budget.
- County
  - Not cutting positions. Final budget hearing in September
- ADMH
  - ADMH has a lot of vacant positions stemming from retirements and resignations. ADMH will be seeking for fill these vacancies.
  - Currently a shortage in Physician hours due to two vacancies. This has caused appointment times to be pushed out significantly; keeping appointments is very crucial.

### **ADMH UPDATE**

- AB100
  - AB 100 created 3 funds for the current Fiscal Year
    - a. Managed Care
    - b. EPSDT
      - i. Given the nature of the EPSDT funding for FY2011-12 and the states interpretation of the federal entitlement as 'statewide'; there is an increased importance on staying within the counties allocation and program budget.
      - ii. This has also created the need for timely and consistent claiming to avoid the loss of any funds.
    - c. Educationally Related Mental Health Services (ERMHS)
      - i. The mandate under AB 3632/Chapter 26.5 for ERMHS has been removed from the County and placed with Education.
      - ii. Education, statewide, has taken the position that Medication Services are not covered. It is unclear at this point how this will impact access to these services.
      - iii. The County will continue to serve Medi-Cal recipients.
      - iv. YCOE has issued an RFP.
- MHSA Planning Innovation and Housing
  - The second hour of the August meeting will be an MHSA Stakeholder meeting.
  - The County has received all MHSA allocations though FY 09/10 as a part of the changes related to the state budget.
