Supervisor Saylor will serve on this board with representatives from other counties, cities and school boards throughout California.

The Cities Counties School Partnership was created as a vehicle for the three partnering associations – the California State Association of Counties, the California School Boards Association, and the League of California Cities – to identify common issues, discuss mutual challenges and explore alternative strategies to improve the conditions of children, families and communities at the local level. The 2012 Chairman of the CCS Partnership is John Gioia, Contra Costa County Supervisor and Vice-President of the California State Association of Counties.
