Dear Resident:

Water districts throughout California are requesting residents use water more efficiently to help protect the environment and ensure adequate supplies this year.

Wild Wings County Service Area water and wastewater operators, California American Water, in conjunction, Wild Wings CSA is encouraging residents to reduce water usage by at least ten percent. Currently, the annual water allotment per residence in Wild Wings is 250,000 gallons per year. As shown below, the average Wild Wings residence uses 286,944 gallons per year. This is more than 10 % above the 250,000 gallon annual allotment.

Below is usage information that illustrates the significant range of individual water use for fiscal year 2010-2011:

184 households are over the 250,000 gallon allotment \$12,364.66 will be collected due to water overage charges

Average usage: 286,944 Gallons Highest Usage: 952,840 Gallons Lowest Usage: 81,200 Gallons

In order to continue to provide low costs for residential water usage, it will be necessary for all residential users to minimize water use. In the future it will be critical to determine cost increases for water usage and for infrastructure improvements, and significant water quality projects including the required arsenic remediation. The impact of reducing water usage is to lower system maintenance costs and lower individual water bills.

If your water statement is higher than the 250,000 gallon annual allotment please request a water audit from the CSA/California American Water if you have not done so already.

In the months ahead, please use water wisely – both to protect our environment and to avoid paying a higher water bill.
