Why Choose Yolo?

- Average wait time at scales is less than 3 minutes, saving you time and money.
- Conveniently located just a few minutes off of Interstate 5, Interstate 80 or Highway 113.
- Open 7 days a week offering hours to accommodate many schedules.
- High pressure water supplied for truck washout if needed
- All types of payments accepted included cash, check, credit (VISA/MC and DISC) and landfill account invoicing.
- Rates are charged by the ton on inspected and certified scales accurate to 20 pounds – no more second guessing the accuracy of a flow meter or paying for a full load when your tank is half full!
- Base rate starting at \$34/ton (approximately 14 cents per gallon). Contract discounts available depending on quantity and material, call/email for more information.
- Remember to call first if you are a new customer and/or have a new waste stream.



Types of Waste Accepted:

- Septage
- Portable toilet
- Grease trap (pH adjusted)
- Process and rinse water*
- Contaminated groundwater and storm water*
- Concrete grinding slurry*
- Winery
- Directional Boring
- Hydroexcavation mud
- Wash rack sump/car wash liquid*
- Other Non-hazardous liquid waste*

PROCEDURES FOR DISPOSAL:

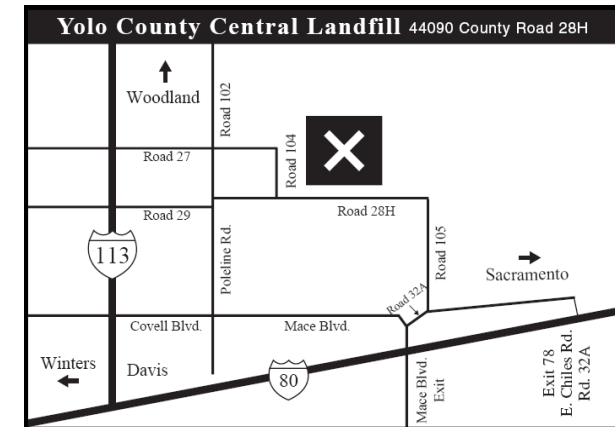
Septic and Liquid Waste must be pre-approved by the Landfill waste acceptance staff. Visit www.yolocounty.org for the 'liquid waste criteria' application or call for specific project requirements. Once a profile number is issued for the project or site, the liquid can be disposed of at our facility during regular operation hours.
