

Yolo DA Announces Fraud Awareness Fair

(Woodland, CA) – August 14, 2012 - District Attorney Jeff Reisig announces that plans are underway for the 5th Annual Yolo & Sacramento Regional Fraud Awareness Fair, which will take place on October 10th, 2012. Local, state and federal law enforcement agencies have collaborated with major corporations, banks, professional organizations, local news media and the West Sacramento Chamber of Commerce to present this educational event. All members of the public are invited to attend. Admission is free.

The City of West Sacramento Police Department will be hosting this year's fair at the Civic Center Galleria, 1110 West Capitol Ave., West Sacramento, CA. The event previously held in July has been moved to October this year to coincide with National Crime Prevention Month.
