(An Ordinance Amending the Yolo County Code Relating to Quorum Requirements for the Park, Recreation and Wildlife Advisory Committee)

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo, State of California, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 2-2.1406 of Chapter 1 of Title 2 of Article 14 of the Yolo County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

### Section 2-2.1406. Meetings: Quorum.

The Park, Recreation, and Wildlife Advisory Committee shall meet on call of the Chairperson with at least one (1) week's written notice of such meeting. A quorum to conduct a meeting shall consist of one-half plus one of the current membership of the Committee. The County Clerk-Recorder shall be notified of the date and time of each meeting of the Committee.

### SECTION 2. Effective Date/Publication.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after its passage, and prior to the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its adoption, it shall be published once in <a href="The Daily Democrat">The Daily Democrat</a>, a newspaper of general circulation, printed and published in the County of Yolo.

ORDINANCE NO. 1067

(An Ordinance to Amend Article 14 of Chapter 2 of Title 2 of the Yolo County Code to Create the Park, Recreation, and Wildlife Advisory Committee)

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo, State of California, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Article 6 of Chapter 2 of Title 2 of the Yolo County Code is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. Section 2-2.1401 of Article 14 of Chapter 2 of Title 2 of the Yolo County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

### Section 2-2.1401. Created.

The Park and Recreation Advisory Committee shall henceforth be known as the Park, Recreation, and Wildlife Advisory Committee.

SECTION 3. Section 2-2.1402 of Article 14 of Chapter 2 of Title 2 of the Yolo County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

### SECTION 2-2.1402. Membership.

The Park, Recreation, and Wildlife Advisory Committee shall consist of ten (10) members appointed by the Board, and each Supervisor shall recommend and nominate two (2) private citizens from the supervisorial district represented by the Supervisor. One (1) member of the Board and the County Administrative Officer shall be ex-officio members of the Committee. The members of the Park and Recreation Advisory Committee disbanded by this ordinance

THE TUNSEL TOLO

shall comprise the initial membership of the Park, Recreation, and Wildlife Committee.

SECTION 4. Section 2-2.1403 of Article 14 of Chapter 2 of Title 2 of the Yolo County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

### Section 2-2.1403. Membership: Terms.

The members of the Park, Recreation, and Wildlife Advisory Committee shall serve at the pleasure of the Board.

SECTION 5. Section 2-2.1404 of Article 14 of Chapter 2 of Title 2 of the Yolo County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

### Section 2-2.1404. Membership: Organization.

The members of the Park, Recreation, and Wildlife Advisory Committee shall elect a chairperson and a vice-chairperson to hold office for a twelve (12) month term at each March meeting. The Park Director, who shall not be a member of the Committee, shall be Secretary of the Committee.

SECTION 6. Section 2-2.1405 of Article 14 of Chapter 2 of Title 2 of the Yolo County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

## Section 2-2.1405. Membership: Expense Reimbursements.

The members of the Park, Recreation, and Wildlife Advisory Committee shall receive reimbursements for their actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties outside the boundaries of the County.

SECTION 7. Section 2-2.1406 of Article 14 of Chapter 2

of Title 2 of the Yolo County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

### Section 2-2.1407. Meetings: Quorum.

The Park, Recreation, and Wildlife Advisory Committee shall meet on call of the Chairperson with at least one (1) week's written notice of such meeting. A quorum to conduct a meeting shall consist of six (6) members of the Committee. The County Clerk-Recorder shall be notified of the date and time of each meeting of the Committee.

SECTION 8. Section 2-2.1407 of Article 14 of Chapter 2 of Title 2 of the Yolo County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

### Section 2-2.1407. Meetings: Minutes.

A copy of the minutes of each meeting of the Park, Recreation, and Wildlife Advisory Committee shall be filed with the Clerk of the Board and the County Administrative Officer.

SECTION 9. Section 2-2.1408 of Article 14 of Chapter 2 of Title 2 of the Yolo County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

### Section 2-2.1408. Duties.

The duties and responsibilities of the Park, Recreation, and Wildlife Advisory Committee shall be as follows:

- (a) To act in an advisory capacity to the Board and Director of Parks;
- (b) To consider the needs of the County with respect to the development of a regional park system;

- (d) To consider proposals or requests submitted by individual citizens or groups;
- (e) To advise and recommend the most economical method for the expenditure of Fish and Game funds; and
- (f) To make recommendations to the Board of Supervisors and the County Administrative Officer about park, recreation, and wildlife matters as may be necessary and desirable.

### SECTION 10. EFFECTIVE DATE/PUBLICATION.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after its passage, and prior to the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage, this ordinance shall be published once in <a href="The Daily Democrat">The Daily Democrat</a>, a newspaper of general circulation, printed and published in the County of Yolo.

(Resolution Amending Membership Provisions of the Yolo County Park and Recreation Advisory Committee)

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 67-14, the Yolo County Board of Supervisors created a Park and Recreation Advisory Committee for the County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has adopted policies to standardize terms of membership on all County advisory committees; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors wishes to bring the terms of the Park and Recreation Advisory Committee into conformance with the Board's policies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Yolo County Board of Supervisors as follows:

Section IV of Resolution No. 67-14 is hereby amended to read:

SECTION IV. Term of Office.

- The initial terms of the members of the Committee shall a. be as follows:
  - Five (5) members shall be appointed for a term 1. of two (2) years.
  - Five (5) members shall be appointed for a term 2. of four (4) years.
- b. Thereafter, all terms shall be for a period of four No member shall serve for more than two consecutive terms; however, an initial two (2) year term shall not be counted

c. Membership shall be effective upon appointment by the Board. However, all terms shall be deemed to have commenced on February 1 following initial appointment, and thereafter all terms shall commence on February 1 and end on January 31.

d. The term of office of a member who has three (3) consecutive unexcused absences from meetings of the Committee may be terminated by the Board after notification of the member. The vacancy thereby created shall be filled by appointment in the same manner as the member being replaced. A person so appointed may then serve a maximum of two (2) additional terms following completion of the unexpired term.

#### RESOLUTION NO. 67-14

(Resolution Creating Yolo County Park and Recreation Advisory Committee)

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo, State of California, as follows:

SECTION I. Creation of Yolo County Park and Recreation Advisory Committee.

There is hereby created the Yolo County Park and Recreation Advisory Committee.

SECTION II. Duties and Responsibilities.

The duties and responsibilities of the Yolo County Park and Recreation Advisory Committee are as follows:

- 1. To act in an advisory capacity to the Board of Supervisors and the County Director of Parks.
- To consider the needs of the county with respect to the development of a regional park system.
- 3. To study and review plans and programs for the long range development of a county park master plan.
- 4. To consider proposals or requests submitted by individual citizens or groups.
- 5. To make such recommendations to the Board of Supervisors and the County Executive as may be necessary and desirable.

### SECTION III. Membership

The Yolo County Park and Recreation Advisory Committee shall consist of ten (10) members appointed by the Board of Supervisors, and each County Supervisor shall recommend and nominate two (2) private citizens from the supervisorial district represented by the Supervisor. One member of the Board of Supervisors and the County Executive shall be ex-officio members of the Committee.

SECTION IV. Term of Office.

The members of the Yolo County Park and Recreation Advisory Committee shall serve at the pleasure of the Board of Supervisors.

### SECTION V. Officers.

At the first meeting the members shall elect a Chairman and a Vice Chairman to hold office for a twelve month term, and at each March meeting thereafter they shall elect the officers for the next succeeding twelve month term. The Yolo County Park Director, who shall not be a member of the Committee, shall be Secretary of the Advisory Committee.

#### SECTION VI. Meetings.

The first regular meeting of the Yolo County Park and Recreation Advisory Committee shall be held in the month of March, 1967, and thereafter shall meet on call of the Chairman, with at least one week's written notice of such meeting. A quorum to conduct a meeting shall consist of six (6) members of the Advisory Committee. The County Clerk shall be notified of the date and time of each meeting of the Advisory Committee.

#### SECTION VII.

A copy of the minutes of each meeting of the Advisory Committee shall be filed with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and the County Executive.

### SECTION VIII. Expenses

Members shall receive reimbursement for their actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties outside the boundaries of the County of Yolo.
