(An Ordinance Amending the Provisions of Certain Sections of Chapter 2 of Title 2 Concerning the Library Advisory Board of the County of Yolo)

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo, State of California, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 2-2.1202 of Article 12 of Chapter 2 of Title 2 of the Yolo County Code hereby is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2-2.1202. Membership.

The Library Advisory Board shall consist of eight (8) members as follows:

- (a) Five (5) rotating members, selected by the Board of Supervisors, one from each of the supervisorial districts, who shall be residents of the district from which appointed; and
- (b) Three (3) permanent membership agencies, which shall be the appointing authorities for their representatives, and which shall be responsible for advising the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in writing of the names of their representatives and any change in their representatives. The three (3) permanent members shall be from the following:
 - (1) The City of Winters;
 - (2) The City of Davis; and
 - (3) The City of West Sacramento.

ORDINANCE NO. 979

(An Ordinance Amending Article 12 Chapter 2 of Title 2 of the Yolo County Code so as to Increase the Terms of Members of the Library Advisory Board from Two Years to Four Years)

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo, State of California, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 2-2.1203 of Article 12 of Chapter 2 of Title 2 of the Yolo County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec 2-2.1203. Membership: Terms: Vacancies.

The terms of rotating members shall be four (4) years and shall commence on February 1 and end on January 31. A vacancy on the Library Advisory Board shall exist upon the death, resignation, or termination of residence within the unincorporated area of the supervisorial district from which appointed. Vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired term by the appointing authority. Each member shall serve until the appointment and qualification of his successor; provided, however, no member shall serve more than two (2) consecutive A one year term shall not be counted as one of the two (2) consecutive terms.

SECTION 2. Persons heretofore appointed to terms commencing on February 1, 1974, shall serve a four-year term. serving terms scheduled to expire on January 31, 1985, shall serve until January 31, 1986. For purpose of the rule

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prohibiting service for more than two consecutive terms, service of less than four (4) years shall not be counted as a term.

EFFECTIVE DATE/PUBLICATION. This ordinance SECTION 3. shall be take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after its adoption, and prior to the expiration of fifteen (15) days after passage, it shall be published once in THE DAILY DEMOCRAT, a newspaper of general circulation, printed and published in the County of Yolo.

ORDINANCE NO. 876

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(Ordinance Amending Membership and Organization Provisions of the Yolo County Library Advisory Board)

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo, State of California, DO ORDAIN as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2-2.1202 of Chapter 2 of Title 2 of the Yolo County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2-2.1202. Membership.

The Library Advisory Board shall consist of seven (7) members as follows:

- (a) Five (5) rotating members selected by the Board of Supervisors, one from each of the supervisorial districts, who shall be residents of the unincorporated areas of the district from which appointed.
- Two (2) permanent membership agencies, which shall be the appointing authority for their representative, and which will be responsible for advising the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in writing of the name of their representative, and of any change in their representative. The two permanent members shall be from the following:
 - (1) The City of Winters
 - (2) The City of Davis

SECTION 2. Section 2-2.1205 of Chapter 2 of Title 2 of the Yolo County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2-2.1205. Meetings: Quorum

The first regular meeting of the Yolo County Library Advisory Board shall be June, 1965, and thereafter regular meetings shall be held bi-monthly. meetings may be held on call of the Chairman with at least one week's written

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notice of such special meeting. The Chairman shall call a special meeting upon receiving the written request of four members of the Advisory Board. A quorum to conduct a regular or special meeting shall consist of a majority of currently appointed members.

SECTION 3. Section 2-2.1207 of Chapter 2 of Title 2 of the Yolo County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2-2.1207. Duties.

The duties and responsibilities of the Yolo County Library Advisory Board are as follows:

- Act in an advisory capacity to the Board of Supervisors and the County Librarian;
- 2. Review library operations and services;
- Consider the needs of the library system pertaining to services and facilities;
- 4. Study and review plans and programs for the long range development of the county library system;
- Consider proposals or requests submitted by individual citizens or groups as may pertain to the county library system;
- 6. Review budget proposals and make its recommendation on the budget to the County Board of Supervisors;
- 7. Make such recommendations to the County Administrative Officer and and Board of Supervisors as may be necessary and desirable.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after adoption, and prior to the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage, this ordinance shall be published once in The Daily Democrat, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the County of Yolo.

SECTION 1. Section 2-2.1202 of Chapter 2 of Title 2 of the Yolo County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2-2.1202. Membership.

The Library Advisory Board shall consist of eight (8) members as follows:

SECTION 2. Section 2-2.1203 of Chapter 2 of Title 2 of the Yolo County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2-2.1203. Membership: Terms: Vacancies.

Initially, the Board of Supervisors shall appoint three (3) rotating members each for a two-year term, and two (2) rotating members each for a one-year term. Such terms shall commence on February 1 following initial appointment. Thereafter, all appointments shall be for a term of two years, and shall commence on February 1 and end on January 31. A vacancy on the Library Advisory Board shall exist upon the death, resignation, or termination of residence within the city or unincorporated area of the supervisorial district from which appointed. Vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired term by the appointing authority. Each member shall serve until the appointment and qualification of his successor; provided, however, no member shall serve more than two (2) consecutive terms. A one-year term shall not be counted as one of the two consecutive terms.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after adoption, and prior to the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage, this ordinance shall be published once in THE DAILY DEMOCRAT, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the County of Yolo.

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31 32 ORDINANCE NO. 558

(An Ordinance Creating the Yolo County Library Advisory Board, providing for its membership and organization, and repealing Ordinance No. 523)

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo, State of California, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

> Creation of Yolo County Library Advisory SECTION I. Board.

There is hereby created the Yolo County Library Advisory Board.

SECTION II. Duties and Responsibilities.

The duties and responsibilities of the Yolo County Library Advisory Board are as follows:

- 1. Act in an advisory capacity to the Board of Supervisors and the County Librarian;
- 2. Review library operations and services;
- 3. Consider the needs of the library system pertaining to services and facilities;
- 4. Study and review plans and programs for the long range development of the county library system;
- 5. Consider proposals or requests submitted by individual citizens or groups as may pertain to the county library system;
- 6. Review budget proposals and make its recommendation on the budget to the County Board of Supervisors.
- 7. Make such recommendations to the County Executive and the Board of Supervisors as may be necessary and desirable.

SECTION III. Membership.

The Yolo County Library Advisory Board shall consist of seven members appointed by the Board of Supervisors, and shall be selected as follows: One member nominated by the City Council of Davis; one member nominated by the City Council of the City of Winters; and five members to be selected by the Board of Supervisors, one from each of the supervisorial districts who shall be residents of the unincorporated area of the District from which appointed.

SECTION IV. Term of Office.

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Initially the Board of Supervisors shall appoint four members each for a two-year term, and three members each for a one-year term, said terms to commence June 1, 1965. Thereafter, all appointments shall be for a term of two years. A vacancy on the board shall exist upon the death, resignation or termination of residence within the City or unincorporated area of the supervisorial district from which appointed and vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired term by the appointing authority. Each member shall serve until appointment and qualification of his successor; however, no member shall serve more than four consecutive terms.

SECTION V. Meetings.

The first regular meeting of the Yolo County Library Advisory Board shall be in June, 1965, and thereafter regular meetings shall be held bi-monthly. Special meetings may be held on call of the Chairman with at least one week's written notice of such special meeting. The Chairman shall call a special meeting upon receiving the written request of four members of the Advisory Board. A quorum to conduct a regular or special meeting shall consist of four members of the Board. The County Clerk shall be notified of the date and time of each meeting of the Board.

SECTION VI. Officers.

At their first meeting, the members shall elect a Chairman and Vice Chairman to hold office for a twelve month term, and at each June meeting thereafter they shall elect members to fill such offices for the next succeeding twelve month terms.

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County Librarian shall be the secretary of the Advisory Board. No person shall hold the office of Chairman for more than two consecutive terms. SECTION VII. Minutes. A copy of the minutes of each meeting of the Advisory Board shall be filed with the County Clerk. SECTION VIII. Repealer. Ordinance No. 523 and all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. SECTION IX: Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the 7th day of September ____, 1966, and prior to the expiration of fifteen (15) days after the passage of this ordinance, it shall be published once in the DAILY DEMOCRAT newspaper of general circulation, printed and published in the County of Yolo. Sec. 2-2.1201. Created.

There is hereby created in the County a board to be known as the Library Advisory Board. (§I, Ord. 558)

Sec. 2-2.1202. Membership.

The Library Advisory Board shall consist of eight (8) members as follows:

- (a) Five (5) rotating members, selected by the Board of Supervisors, one from each of the supervisorial districts, who shall be residents of the district from which appointed; and
- (b) Three (3) permanent membership agencies, which shall be the appointing authorities for their representatives, and which shall be responsible for advising the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in writing of the names of their representatives and any change in their representatives. The three (3) permanent members shall be from the following:
 - (1) The City of Winters;
 - (2) The City of Davis; and
 - (3) The City of West Sacramento.

Vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired term by the appointing authority. Each member shall serve until the appointment and qualification of his successor; provided, however, no member shall serve more than two (2) consecutive terms. A one-year term shall not be counted as one of the two (2) consecutive terms. (§IV, Ord. 558, as amended by § 2, Ord. 830, eff. March 8, 1979, § 1, Ord. 979, eff. August 9, 1984, and § 2, Ord. 1049, eff. February 12, 1987)

Sec. 2-2.1204. Membership: Organization.

At their first meeting, the members of the Library Advisory Board shall elect a chairman and vice-chairman to hold office for a twelve (12) month term, and at each June meeting thereafter the members shall elect members to fill such offices for the next succeeding twelve (12) month term. The County Librarian shall be the secretary of the Library Advisory Board. No person shall hold the office of chairman for more than two (2) consecutive terms (§VI, Ord. 558)

Sec. 2-2.1205. Meetings: Quorum.

The first regular meeting of the Library Advisory Board shall be in June, 1965, and thereafter regular meetings shall be held bimonthly. Special meetings may be held on call of the chairman with at least one week's written notice of such special meeting. The chairman shall call a special meeting upon receiving the written request of four (4) members of said Board. A quorum to conduct a regular or special meeting shall consist of a majority of the currently appointed members of said Board. (§V, Ord. 558, as amended by § 2, Ord. 876, eff. May 8, 1980)

The duties and responsibilities of the Library Advisory Board shall be as follows:

- (a) To act in an advisory capacity to the Board of Supervisors and the County Librarian;
- (b) To review library operations and services;
- (c) To consider the needs of the library system pertaining to services and facilities;
- (d) To study and review plans and programs for the long-range development of the County library system;
- (e) To consider proposals or requests submitted by individual citizens or groups, which proposals or requests may pertain to the County library system;
 - (f) To review budget proposals and make recommendations on the budget to the Board of Supervisors; and
