### MINUTES

Joint Meeting – Aviation Advisory/Airport Development Advisory Committees  
August 29, 2000

1. The Meeting was called to order outside Lillard Hall, Yolo County Airport, at 7:35 p.m.

2. The meeting was opened for public comment on items not on the Agenda. There were no comments from the public.

There being no public comment, the meeting returned to the Agenda.

3. Self introductions were conducted around the table.

4. The minutes of the last meeting were corrected, but there being no quorum of the Aviation Advisory Committee, no action was taken.

5. The Blue Max Cart Club presented its proposed project for a race tract facility at the Airport. Discussion ensued. Questions focused on service of Alcohol (NO); Concessions (Yes); Cost of improvements (\$225 - \$250,000); at maximum, 600 people/200 cars over an entire day of racing (i.e., races are staggered by

classification); noise (a dB handout indicated noise at different locations) race day is 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., generally two day events, from 12 to 20 per year.

Ray Ferrell of Skydance (Prestar) asked about competition with their operations due to parking, traffic during race day, multiple events on the same days, storm water drainage and oil runoff. Additionally, Prestar raised the issue that the area adjacent to Yolo Sportsman's is designated BALLOON LAUNCH AREA (Special Event Drop Zone) and therefore it should not be considered for the Kart Klub

6. Discussion of the airport facilities included the need for a new well, weed abatement, runway maintenance, park upgrade and trees blocking Aviation Blvd., drainage, and jet noise test equipment.
7. Any updated from Yolo Aviation? No. Woodland Aviation - continuing with plans to expand.
8. New Business. The process of notifying "all the world" as a courtesy was addressed. It was agreed, that in the interest of communication within the whole community, that all committee meetings would be published to "all the world."

Also discussed was potential new improvements at the Airport, and in dealing with the FAA for Grant funds. An AWOS (automatic weather system) was discussed, along with re-naming the Airport. More County Tie Downs were requested.

9. The meeting was adjourned to October 24, 2000.

The meeting adjourned at 9:05 p.m.
