Free Holiday Recycling at the Landfill December 26 to January 12

(Woodland, CA) – Free recycling of residential holiday trees (treecycling) is being offered at the Yolo County Central Landfill December 26 through January 12. Treecycling turns household holiday trees into valuable renewable and recyclable resources. Trees to be recycled should be free of all ornaments, flocking, tinsel, garland and lights. Limit two free trees per Yolo County resident.

Additionally, electronics, such as computers, TVs and monitors, and paper, plastics, cans and bottles can also be recycled every day at the landfill, located at 44090 County Road 28H in Woodland.

“Holiday trees are biodegradable and will eventually decompose to provide essential organic matter,” said Yolo County Board of Supervisors Chair Jim Provenza. “By recycling your holiday tree, gift boxes, bottles and cans from holiday celebrations, you will help reduce waste in our landfill and are doing your part to help the environment.”
