Digital Download Workshops in January

(Woodland, CA) – Three workshops will be held in January at the Mary L. Stephens Branch Library, located at 315 E. 14th Street in Davis, to assist residents with using the Yolo County Library's free digital media download service.

“Pew International reports that 58% of all library card holders say they do not know if their library provides e-book lending services,” said Yolo County Librarian Patty Wong. “We do, and we invite the Yolo County community to come to a workshop and discover how to use their digital devices to access library materials for free.”

On Thursday, January 3, 7:00 to 8:30 p.m., the workshop will focus on how to use the service to download eBooks to a Kindle or a device using the Kindle Reading App. Participants should bring their charged device, wireless laptop (optional), library card, USB cable and Amazon.com account sign-in and password.

On Thursday, January 17, 7:00 to 8:30 p.m., the workshop will focus on how to use the service to download eBooks and audiobooks to an iPad, iPhone or iPod Touch. Participants should bring their charged device, library card, USB cable, Apple ID and password and Adobe Digital Editions ID and password (if they have one).

On Thursday, January 24, 7:00 to 8:30 p.m., the workshop will focus on how to use the service to download eBooks to a NOOK Simple Touch, Color or Tablet. Participants should bring their charged device, USB cable, library card and Adobe Digital Editions ID and password (if they have one).

Following demonstrations in each workshop, Yolo County Library staff will be available to answer questions.

All workshops are free and will be held in the Blanchard Room of the Mary L. Stephens Davis Branch Library which is accessible for persons with disabilities. No reservations are required. For more information on Yolo County Library programs, visit: www.yolocountylibrary.org.
