PUBLIC COMMENT

PUBLIC COMMENT	A charter meeting was announced of the Yolo Friends of the Library, April 9 th , 6.00P; election of Brd. of Directors, etc.
	There is still substantial community concern regarding the Compost Facility, seems to be differing answers to similar questions, seems to be a bidding competition between the county landfill and Northern Recycling. Additional concern with Yolo County getting into the compost business directly; is the county actually going to operate a compost facility?
	Also concern was voiced regarding what was felt to be a shortcoming in the public announcement process regarding the expansion of the Zamora compost facility from the original application by Northern Recycling through the negative declaration. With a facility that had the potential to impact the whole community at large, formally announcing through the mail only residents within 300 feet seemed to be quite inadequate. The odor if nothing else can be evident for 4-5 miles.
	There were also questions regarding applicable rules and whether, since Northern Recycle was originally permitted, some new rules cannot be implemented because old rules are "grandfathered" in.
