Yolo County Library Celebrates Día de los Niños/Día de los Libros April 4 - May 20

(Woodland, CA) – Día de los Niños/Día de los Libros (Children’s Day/Book Day), a nationwide festival of children, books and literacy, will be celebrated at all Yolo County Library branches starting on April 20, and concluding on May 4. Children of all ages are invited to bring their families to the below listed celebrations where they can enjoy dance performances, stories, songs, crafts, face-painting and other family-friendly activities.

“Día de los Niños/Día de los Libros brings families together, further strengthening our communities,” said Yolo County Librarian Patty Wong.

Día de los Niños/Día de los Libros is a special day set aside to recognize the importance of literacy for children of all linguistic and cultural backgrounds. One of the goals of this event is to help build home libraries. With that in mind, the Yolo County Library will be distributing free books to all children in attendance. Additionally, three of the branch libraries (West Sacramento, Winters and Davis [Mary L. Stephens]) will feature a special presentation by local children’s author, Frank Araujo.
