



DUI Offender Process




Following the arrest for a DUI, offenders present themselves in court. Upon court conviction, the DMV and DUI program are notified of the offender, and the offender is referred to a DUI program. It is the offender's responsibility to enroll in a DUI program; failure to do so will result in a notification to the court for a re-referral. The DUI program notifies the court and DMV of an offender's enrollment in, completion, or dismissal from the program.




3 Month 23152 (B.A.C. > .08-.19)




6 Month

B.A.C. > .15 & Above (or Refusal of Chemical Test or Accompanied by a minor)




9 Month
