

Capay Valley Citizens Advisory Committee Meeting

1. Call to order at 7:06
2. Approval of minutes moved by Don seconded by Todd. Approved unanimously
3. Correspondence and announcements. None
4. Public comment. None.
5. Informational item- public works update on the Rumsey Bridge. Panos Kokkas gave a presentation and answered questions about the status of the Rumsey Bridge renovation. He assured us that there will be plenty of time to consider historic needs during the EIR. Topics discussed included the following:
 - The aerial land/topographic survey has been completed.
 - Based on the survey we are working on the hydraulic studies, which will determine the flood footprint and water elevation of the channel, before we can establish the possibility and costs for both options, retrofit or replacement of the bridge.
 - The geotechnical engineer has determined the seismic response curve so the existing bridge can be analyzed. Once that analysis is complete, a retrofit strategy can be developed, and cost estimates prepared to compare alternatives. Additional geotechnical investigations (deep test holes in the channel bed) will also be required before we can determine the exact cost for each option.
 - A meeting at the Rumsey Town Hall will be planned so neighboring residents can have their comments included in the EIR.
