The Sacramento District of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers released an evaluation Thursday of both the right and left banks of Putah Creek, which flows just south of Davis. It rated the maintenance of the levee systems as unacceptable. The proposed Bay Delta Conservation Plan would impact Yolo County, so local representatives were on hand at the news conference, including Yolo County Supervisors Jim Provenza and Don Saylor, both from Davis, and Mark Pruner of Clarksburg, a representative of North Delta Cares.
