## Doxycycline drug interactions

☐ Isotretinoin (Accutane) may cause a slight risk of pseudotumor cerebri. Stop if headache develops.

Fluoroquinolone drug interactions

Fluoroquinolone dose may need adjustment based on creatinine clearance.

- ☐ Theophylline levels increase. Your patient was advised to decrease the theophylline dose by one-half.
- □ Ropinirole effects may be increased resulting in toxicity.
- Dilantin levels may increase or decrease. Check level and adjust as needed.
- □ Cyclosporine plus Cipro may result in increased serum creatinine. Check renal function.
- □ Glyburide plus Cipro rarely results in severe hypoglycemia. Monitor blood sugar initially.
