

Summary of Next Step Recommendations

1. Work with County staff leadership to:
 - Design and initiate a “restart” for public input from the West Plainfield area concerning Yolo airport operations
 - Develop a “good neighbor” policy with and for residents in close proximity to the airport
 - Designate a three-person staff team to support airport planning efforts, initially including representation from planning, public works and economic development
 - Identify issues for which joint fact-finding and fact-checking is needed, and clarify county interests related to:
 - airport finances and accounting practices
 - airport infrastructure, including stormwater issues
 - consistency among FAA, regional and local airport planning documents and requirements
 - updates on current and upcoming airport-related activities and initiatives
 - economic development goals
 - Conduct the data collection and analyses needed to support joint fact-finding
 - Develop a communications plan, including communicating next steps to interested parties
2. Initiate the restart of the public involvement process by conducting a joint County staff/public workshop (including the two advisory committees) on principles and practices for enhancing public input
3. Conduct a staff/public workshop on key issues related to joint fact-finding, as noted above, as well as a good neighbor policy
4. Assess the best approach for continuing public input on airport issues (e.g., providing County staff with a strategy for a focused review of the Airport Master plan that includes community input), and implement the selected approach, ensuring sufficient resources are allocated to adequately support the selected approach
