Free Holiday Recycling at the County Landfill

(Woodland, CA) – The Yolo County Department of Planning & Public Works, Division of Integrated Waste Management is again offering a number of ways for residents to recycle this holiday at the Yolo County Central Landfill, located at 44090 County Road 28H in Woodland.

Free recycling of residential holiday trees (treecycling) is being offered at the landfill from December 26 through January 15. Treecycling turns household holiday trees into a valuable renewable and recyclable resource. As holiday trees are biodegradable, they eventually decompose to provide essential organic matter. Limit two trees per resident, free of ornaments, flocking, tinsel, garland and lights.

Residents can also recycle old electronics, such as computers, TVs and monitors that were upgraded during the holidays, and paper, plastics, cans and bottles for free every day at the landfill.

“By recycling your holiday tree, gift boxes, bottles and cans from holiday celebrations, you will help reduce waste in our landfill and you will be doing your part to help the environment,” said Yolo County Supervisor Matt Rexroad.
