I, the undersigned, say, on information and belief, that in the County of Yolo, State of California:

Count 1: On or about November 18, 2013, WILLIAM CARL GARDNER III did commit a FELONY, namely, a violation of Section 187(a) of the California Penal Code, MURDER, in that WILLIAM CARL GARDNER III did willfully and unlawfully kill a human being, to wit, L.P., with malice aforethought.

Count Enhancement 1a: It is further alleged that during the commission or attempted commission of the felony charged above, WILLIAM CARL GARDNER III did willfully, unlawfully, intentionally, and personally discharge a firearm, and

proximately cause death, within the meaning of Section .

12022.53(d) of the California Penal Code, INTENTIONAL AND PERSONAL DISCHARGE OF FIREARM CAUSING DEATH.

Count Enhancement 1b: It is further alleged that at the time of the commission of offense charged in Count 1, WILLIAM CARL GARDNER III was released from custody on bail or own recognizance for a pending felony offense, within the meaning of Section 12022.1(b) of the California Penal Code, ENHANCEMENT FOR FELONY COMMITTED WHILE RELEASED ON BAIL OR RECOGNIZANCE.

Count Enhancement 1c: It is also alleged that defendant is subject to a SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCE within the meaning of Section 190.2(a)(15) of the California Penal Code in that defendant intentionally killed the victim, L.P., by means of lying in wait.

Count 2: On or about November 15, 2013, to November 18, 2013, WILLIAM CARL GARDNER III did commit a FELONY, namely, a violation of Section 646.9(c) of the California Penal Code, STALKING AFTER HAVING BEEN CONVICTED OF FELONY STALKING, in that WILLIAM CARL GARDNER III did willfully, maliciously, and repeatedly follow and harass another person, to wit, L.P. and did make a credible threat with the intent to place said person in reasonable fear for that person's safety and for the safety of that person's immediate family and that said stalking occurred after WILLIAM CARL GARDNER III had been convicted of any felony violation of Section 273.5 of the California Penal Code on March 13, 2013, in the County of Sacramento.

Count Enhancement 2a : It is further alleged that at the time of the commission of offense charged in Count 2, WILLIAM

CARL GARDNER III was released from custody on bail or own recognizance for a pending felony offense, within the meaning of Section 12022.1(b) of the California Penal Code, ENHANCEMENT FOR FELONY COMMITTED WHILE RELEASED ON BAIL OR RECOGNIZANCE.

Count 3: On or about November 18, 2013, WILLIAM CARL GARDNER III did commit a FELONY, namely, a violation of Section 29800(a)(1) of the California Penal Code, POSSESSION OF FIREARM BY PERSON PREVIOUSLY CONVICTED OF A FELONY, in that WILLIAM CARL GARDNER III did willfully and unlawfully own, purchase, receive, or possess and have under WILLIAM CARL GARDNER III's custody and control any firearm after WILLIAM CARL GARDNER III had been previously convicted of a felony under the laws of the State of California, the United States or any other state, government, or country, or of an offense enumerated in subdivision (a), (b), or (d) of Section 23515

Count Enhancement 3a: It is further alleged that at the time of the commission of offense charged in Count 3, WILLIAM CARL GARDNER III was released from custody on bail or own recognizance for a pending felony offense, within the meaning of Section 12022.1(b) of the California Penal Code, ENHANCEMENT FOR FELONY COMMITTED WHILE RELEASED ON BAIL OR RECOGNIZANCE.
