Healthy Yolo Forces of Change Assessment Now Available

(Woodland, CA) – Recently, the Yolo County Health Department, through the Healthy Yolo campaign, conducted a work session to assess the threats and opportunities around forces of change in relation to the public health system. The resulting Forces of Change Assessment report is now available at www.HealthyYolo.org.

Healthy Yolo is a long-term systematic effort to improve community health. Since July, Healthy Yolo has been engaging the community to share and together understand the specific health concerns and strengths of the community, prioritize public health issues, and determine goals and strategies to achieve a healthier Yolo County.

Twenty-one representatives from the local public health system attended the Forces of Change session. After identifying possible forces of change, which included social, economic, political, technological and environmental, the participants then worked to identify possible threats and opportunities for each. The Forces of Change Assessment was an outcome of the session.
