THIS IS ONLY A DRILL! On May 24, 2006, Yolo County will be coordinating a field exercise in response to a simulated Bio-Hazard TEST Alert in West Sacramento. Our objectives are to coordinate HazMat units from the Sacramento region to provide mass decontamination to a large number of people, have Health Department personnel rapidly screen and dispense prophylaxis and to organize a Joint Information Command for media information.

In a real event, the Health Department would alert our medical providers and emergency response partner agencies to the possibility of contamination or a disease outbreak and provide guidance on signs, symptoms, lab testing, prophylaxis and treatment. Residents under a physician's care would be instructed to advise their physician about prophylaxis medications which were provided to them.
