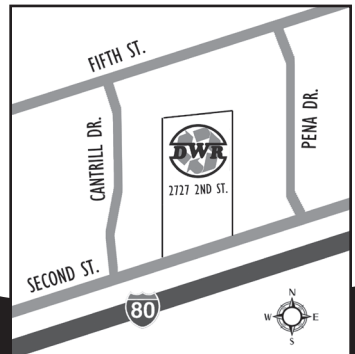
This service is available to Davis Waste Removal customers only.  
ID may be required, no charge to participate.  
Commercial haulers and business materials will not be accepted.

**Acceptable Materials:** Large appliances (refrigerators, freezers—limit of 2), toilets, sinks, plumbing fixtures, scrap metal, wood scraps, furniture, mattresses, textiles, empty cardboard boxes, electronics (TVs, computer monitors, keyboards, microwaves, cell phones, CPUs, printers, coffee makers, etc.), and other bulky items.

**Material Preparation:** Please try to separate materials whenever possible so that materials can easily be recycled at the drop-off site.

**Salvage Area:** There will be a salvage area where usable items, such as furniture, will be separated and stored for reuse; these items can be taken for free.

**Unacceptable Materials:** Business waste, soil, dirt, concrete, asphalt, construction debris, automobile and truck tires, hazardous waste, regular household garbage, and furniture with lead paint.

## WHAT IF I CAN'T TRANSPORT MY BULKY ITEMS TO DAVIS WASTE REMOVAL (DWR)?

You can carpool with friends and neighbors to transport your bulky items to DWR. Individuals who currently subscribe to senior/disabled trash service can call DWR at 756-4646 for a special pickup appointment. DWR also offers a special bulky items pick up service to residents—fees will apply.

## WHAT IF I WANT TO DISPOSE OF MY ITEM BEFORE OR AFTER THE DROP-OFF DAYS?

Reusable items can be donated to a local thrift store or charity, or can be listed in the free section of the Davis Enterprise classified ads. Check out the online Recyclopedia at [DavisRecycling.org](http://DavisRecycling.org) to find out how to recycle and reuse over 200 different items. You can also take materials to the Yolo County landfill (standard landfill fees will apply). For details, call 666-8729.

## OTHER RECYCLING OPTIONS:

Cardboard, rigid plastics #1 - #7, metal cans, paper, glass bottles, scrap metal, and used motor oil & oil filters can be recycled 24 hours-a-day, 7 days-a-week at DWR (2727 2nd St.).

**TIRES:** The landfill accepts tires for \$1.50-\$7 each, depending on size.

## FREE HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE DROP-OFF

Every Friday and Saturday from 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. at the Yolo County Central Landfill.

This program is for Yolo County residents only. Business waste accepted by appointment only.

Accepted items include:

- acids
- automotive fluids
- fire extinguishers
- floor and furniture cleaners
- fluorescent bulbs & tubes
- gasoline & other flammables
- household cleaners
- mercury thermostats
- mercury thermometers
- oil filters
- paint (oil & latex)
- pesticides and herbicides
- pharmaceuticals (non-controlled)
- poisons
- pool chemicals
- propane canisters
- solvents
- syringes
- used motor oil
- and more!

Senior & disabled residents who are unable to drive may call 666-8856 to schedule a free pick up of their hazardous waste.
