Probation's Mr. Pistochini went over our CCP funding by project over all fiscal years. Chief Cardall explained we are at a \$600K deficit at the close of our last meeting on September 8th.

The CCP discussed many of the following in order to reduce the deficit – relying on salary savings, treatment dollars, inpatient health care costs, Prop. 48, realignment dollars, and COPS revenue.

It was decided the following would be reduced:

- \$70K reduction made to Local Law Enforcement allocation which is offset by an increase in the COPS funds they received this year,
- A pro-rata cut was made with the remaining to all of the other allocations based on the total share of Realignment dollars each department/agency receives for program support.
